Career Resource Center (CRC): open 8:30 am to 4:30 pm - with some limited closed sessions. Staff assistance hours vary.

CASAS Testing: Basic Reading and Math Assessment Testing. Find out what your grade level is for each, to further your education or for job search.

Food Handler Cards: You must bring \$10 cash or check, have several hours to prep and take the online course, and if you pass with 75% or better, you will receive your certificate that day. Certificate good for 3 years from that date. (no appointments!)

Networking Job Club: Networking - Job Leads - Job Search. This is a group of peers in supporting each other in job search efforts. Participation is encouraged.

Proctored Typing Test: Need a typing certificate? Attend our FREE typing test and receive a certificate upon completion. No appointment necessary. 9:00am and 11:00am every Friday or see the CRC calendar for Staff times.

SparkPoint: Open Job Search assistance and help with basic Word and basic Internet searching. Call (707) 344-6854 to schedule. 1:30pm 4th Tuesday of each month.
