**Food Handler Cards:** You must bring \$10 cash or check, have several hours to prep and take the online course, and if you pass with 75% or better, you will receive your certificate that day. Certificate good for 3 years from that date.

**Networking Job Club:** Networking - Job Leads - Job Search. This is a group of peers in supporting each other in job search efforts. Participation is encouraged.

**Proctored Typing Test:** Need a typing certificate? Attend our FREE typing test and receive a certificate upon completion. No appointment necessary.
