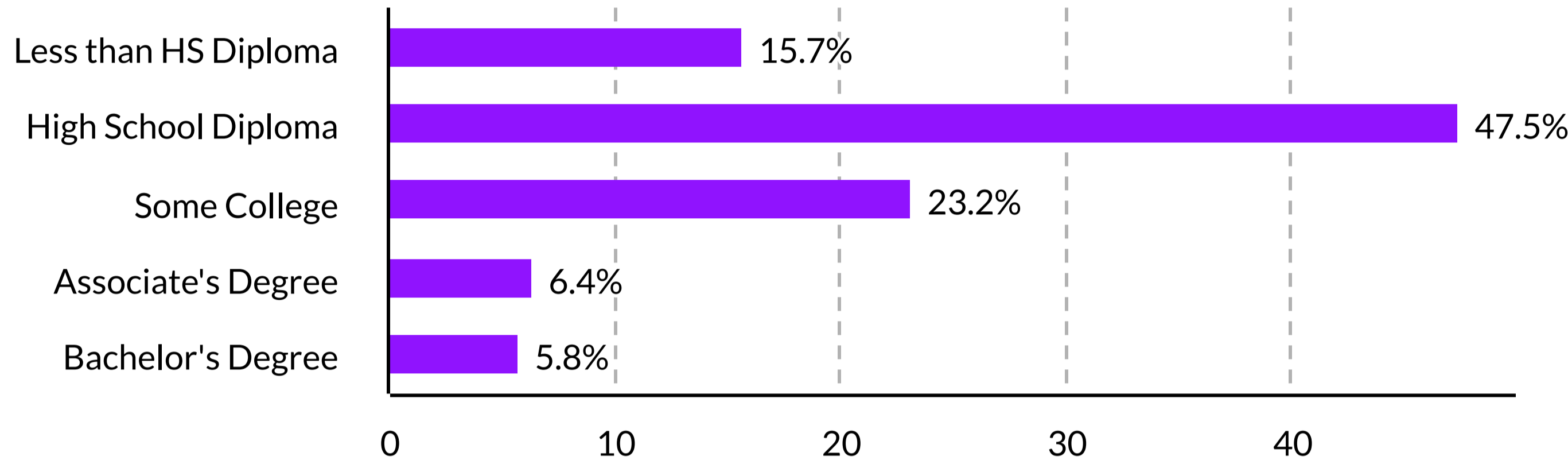

In 2020, the median compensation for CDL-A Truck Drivers in Solano County, CA is \$23.09/hr. Based on the national median wage of \$22.54/hr for this position, this means you will spend about 2% more to employ CDL-A Truck Drivers here. However, their actual purchasing power will be 23% less than the national median when we adjust for regional cost of living (which is 32% higher than average). This may make it harder to attract talent to the region at this price.

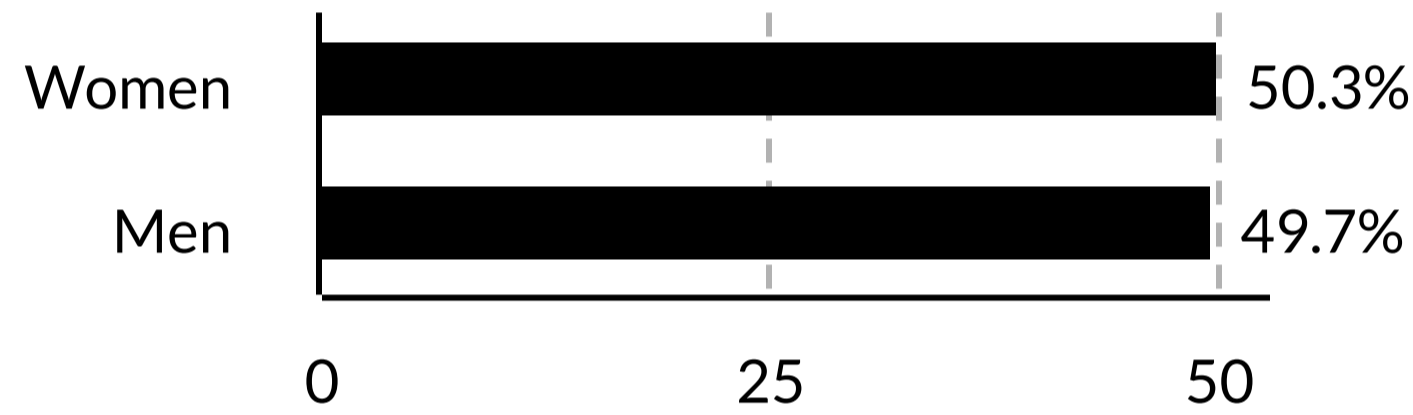
### Industry Educational Attainment Breakdown



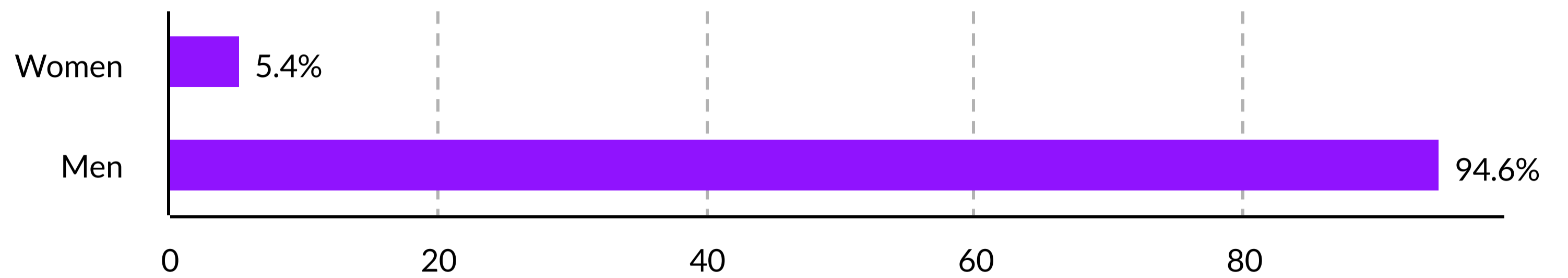
### Concerning Educational Attainment

 10.4% hold an Associate's Degree (1.8% above the national average)

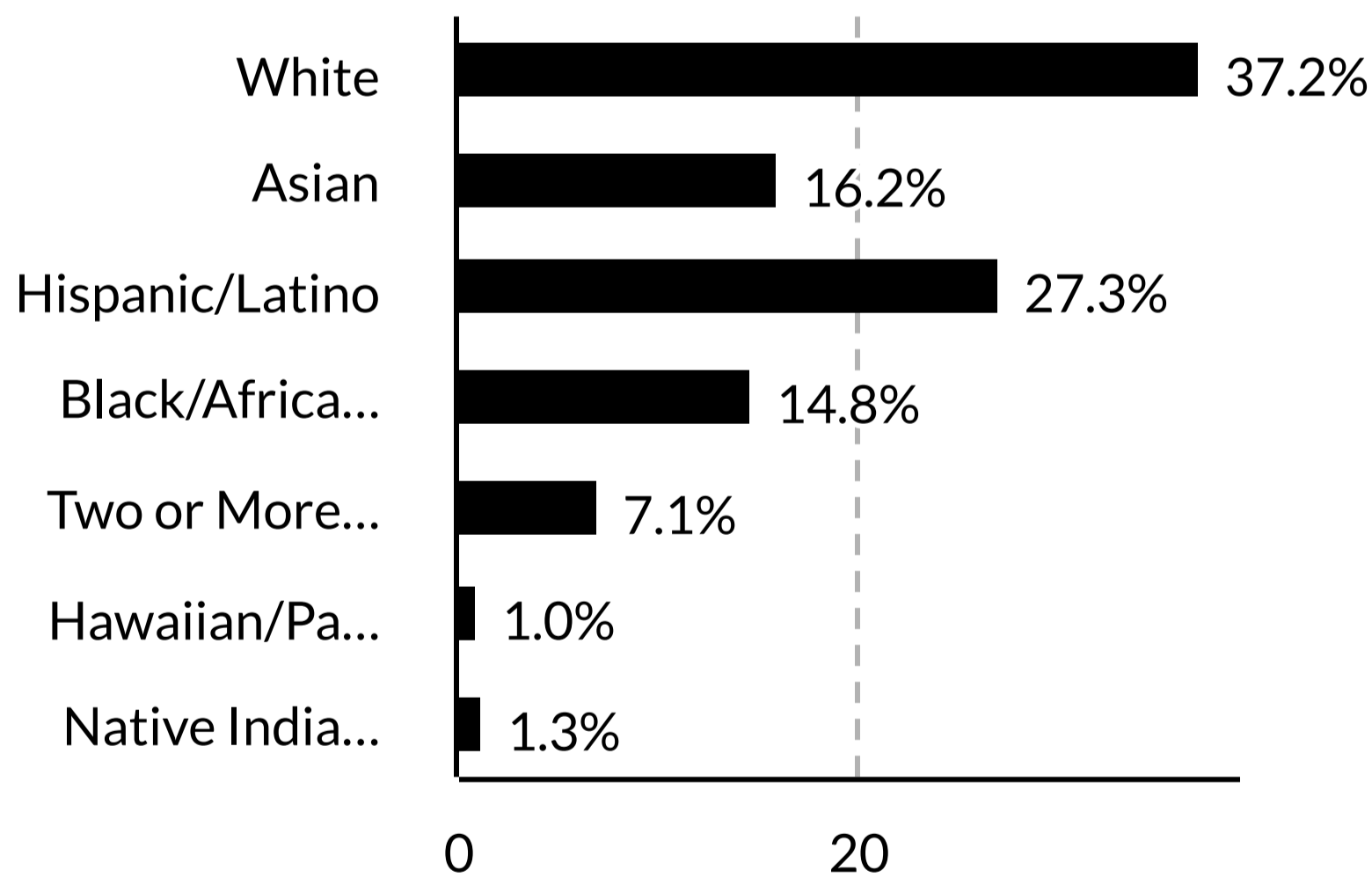
### Solano County Gender Breakdown



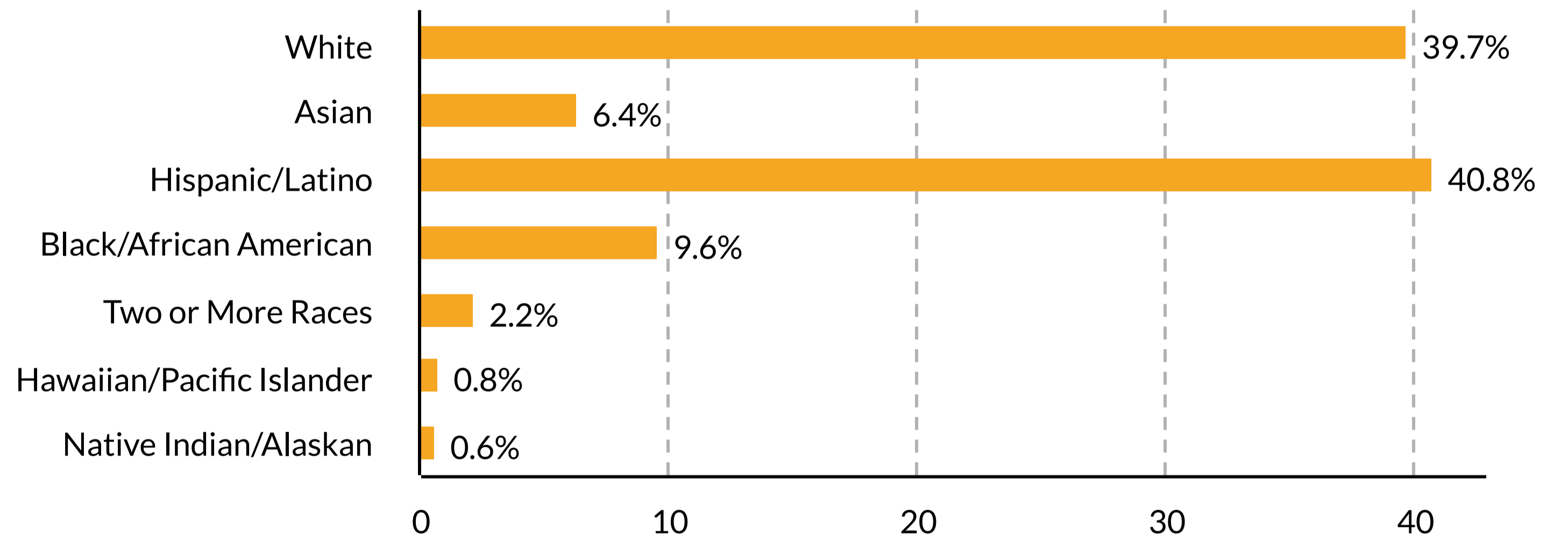
### Occupation Gender Breakdown
