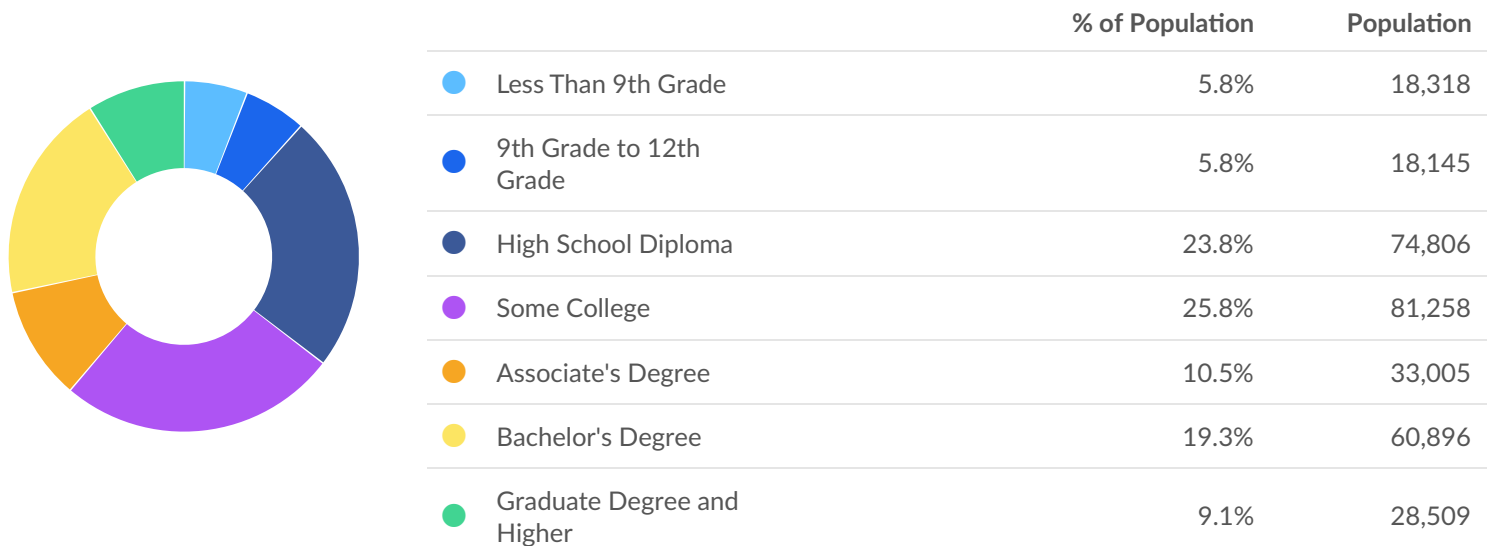
Median household income is \$21.9K above the national median household income of \$75.1K.

Takeaways

- As of 2023 the region's population increased by 0.7% since 2018, growing by 3,287. Population is expected to decrease by 0.0% between 2023 and 2028, losing 65.
- From 2018 to 2023, jobs declined by 0.4% in Solano County, CA from 166,040 to 165,330. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 4.5% by 4.9%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 59.9% to 58.0% between 2018 and 2023.
- Concerning educational attainment, 19.3% of Solano County, CA residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (1.8% below the national average), and 10.5% hold an Associate's Degree (1.6% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2023 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Federal Government, Military.

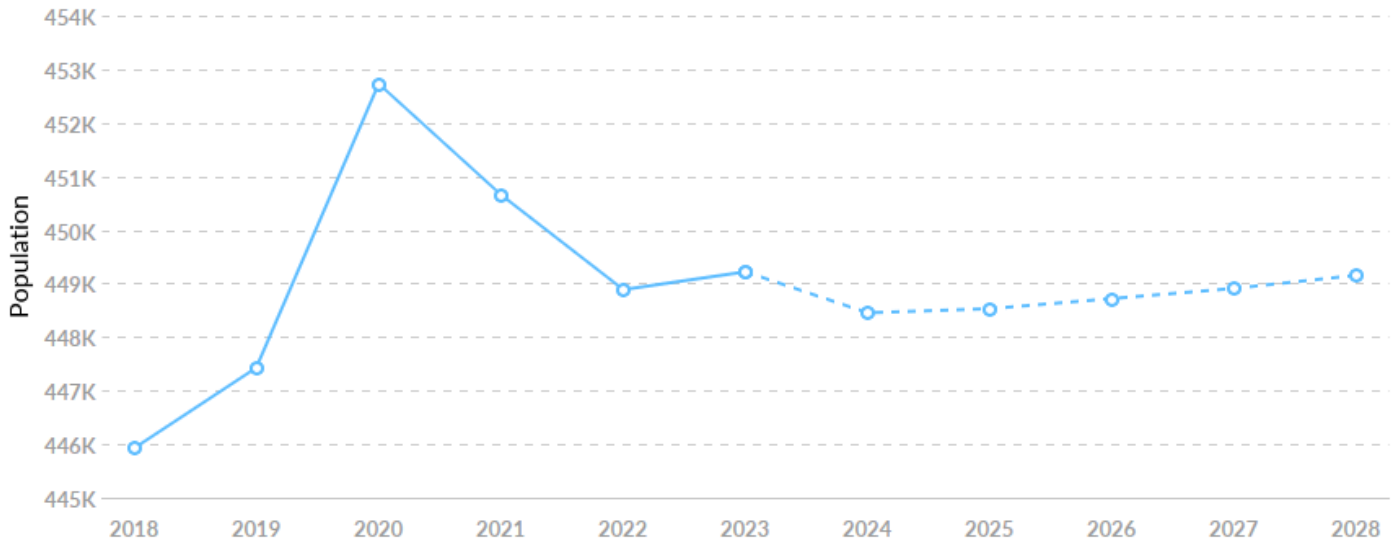

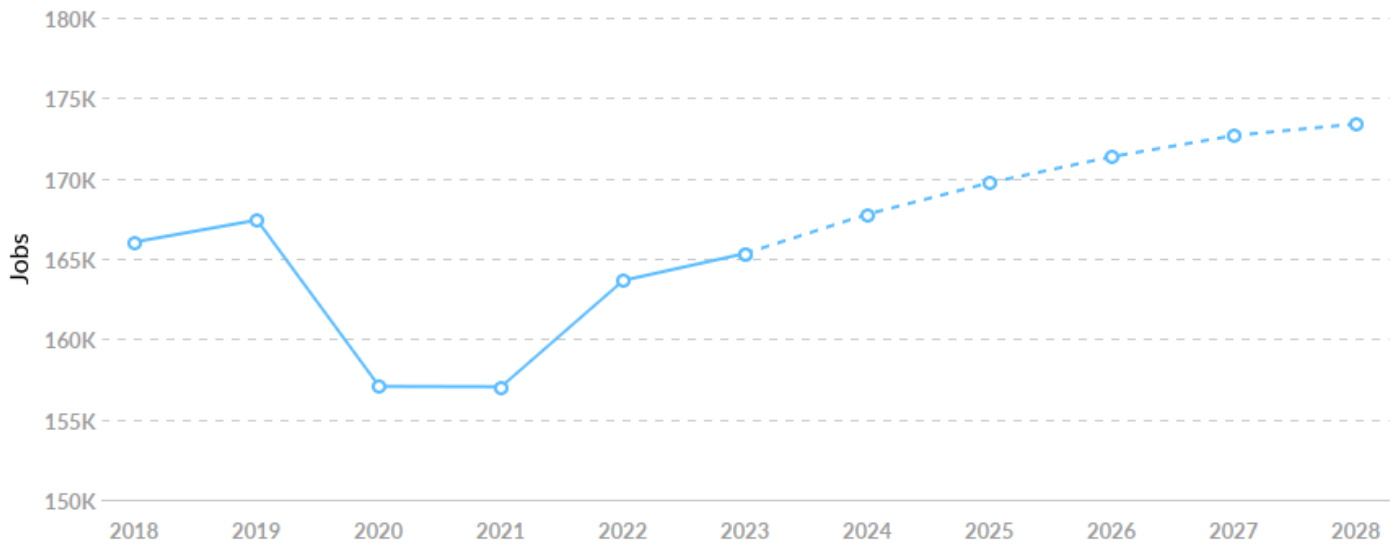

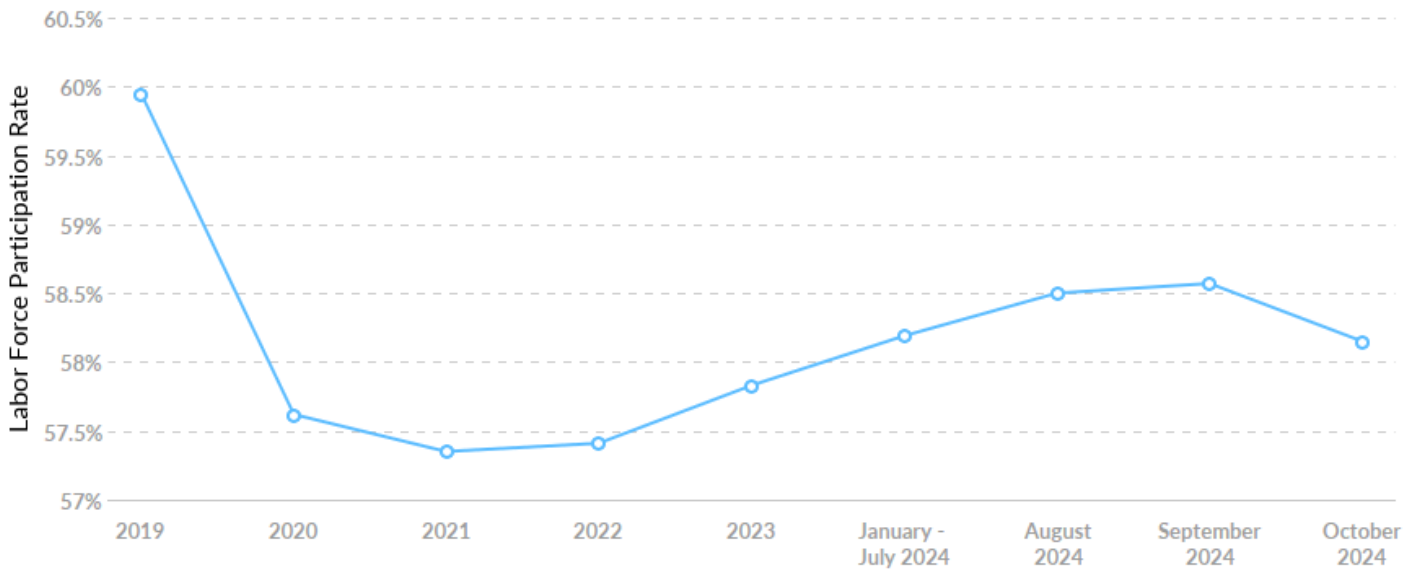
Job Trends

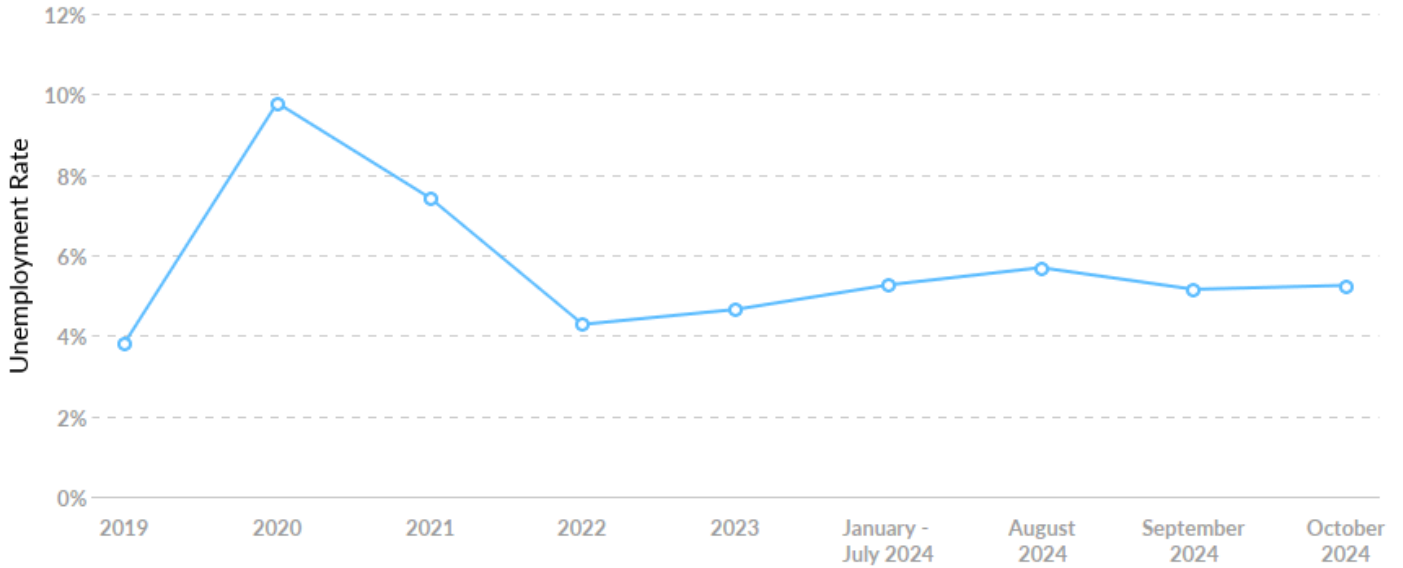

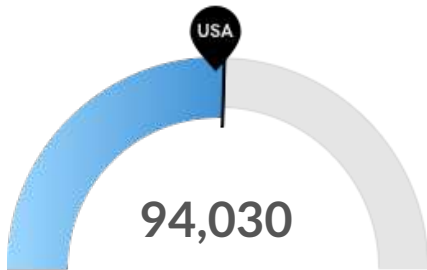
Unemployment Rate Trends

Solano County, CA had an October 2024 unemployment rate of 5.25%, **increasing from 3.81%** 5 years before.



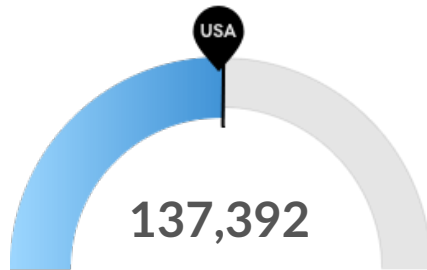

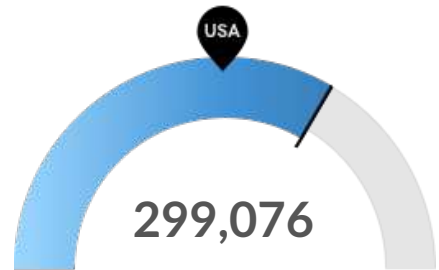
Millennials

Solano County, CA has 94,030 millennials (ages 25-39). The national average for an area this size is 91,274.



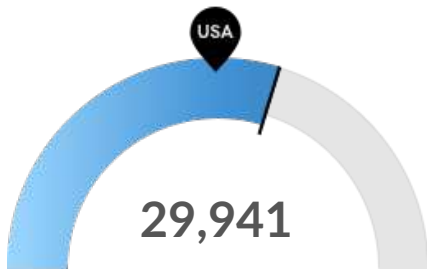
Retiring Soon

Retirement risk is about average in Solano County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 135,608 people 55 or older, while there are 137,392 here.



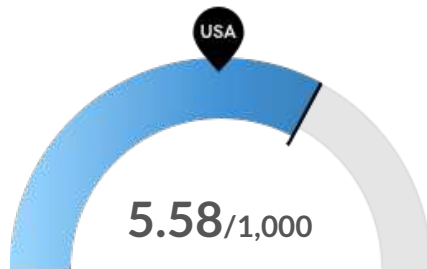
Racial Diversity

Racial diversity is high in Solano County, CA. The national average for an area this size is 187,086 racially diverse people, while there are 299,076 here.



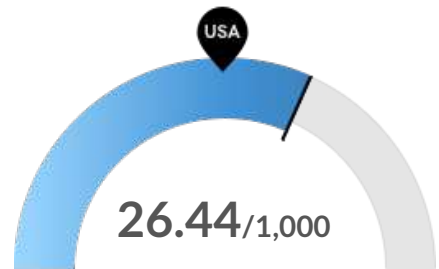
Veterans

Solano County, CA has 5.58 violent crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 3.6 per 1,000 people.

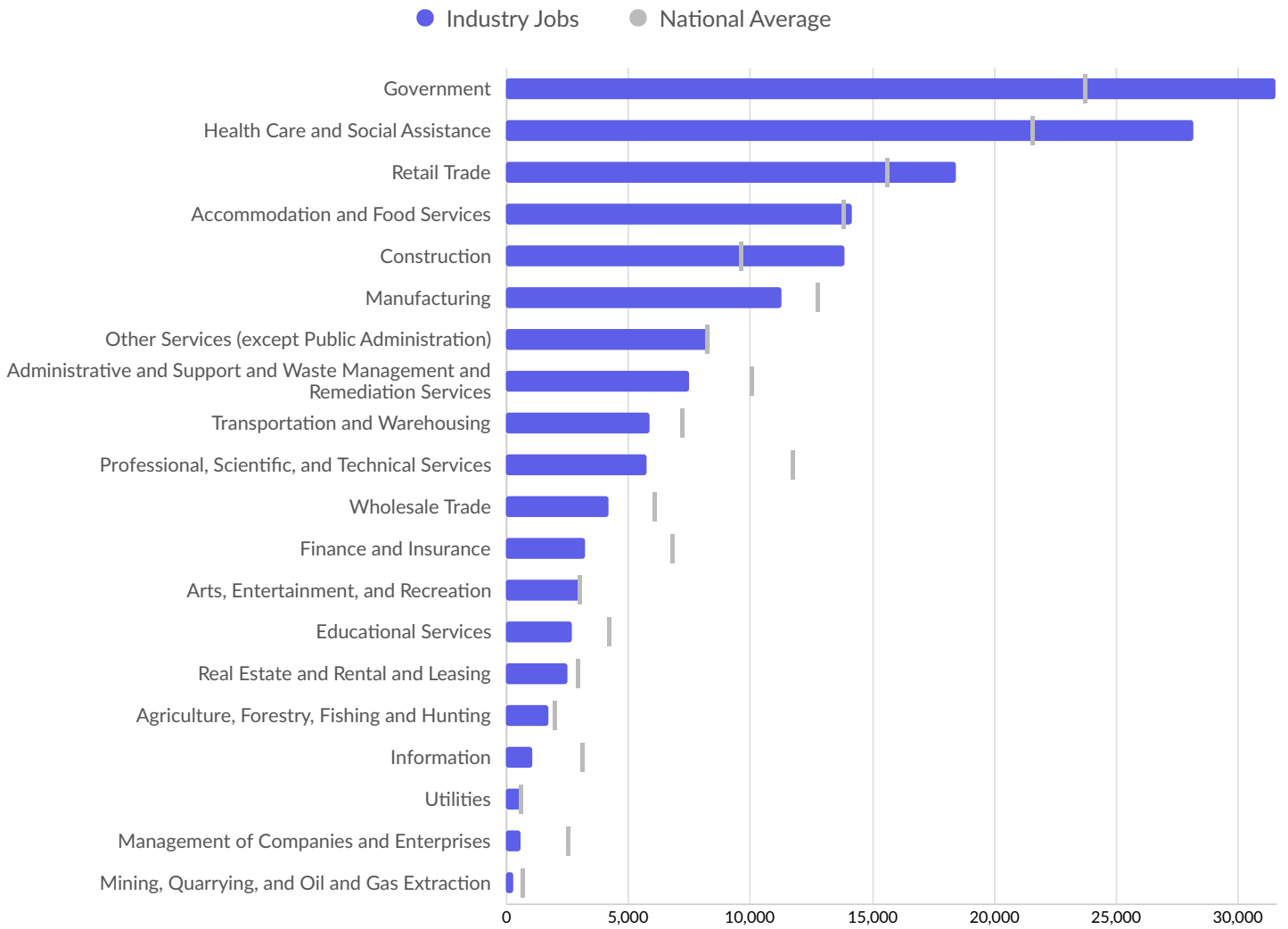


Property Crime

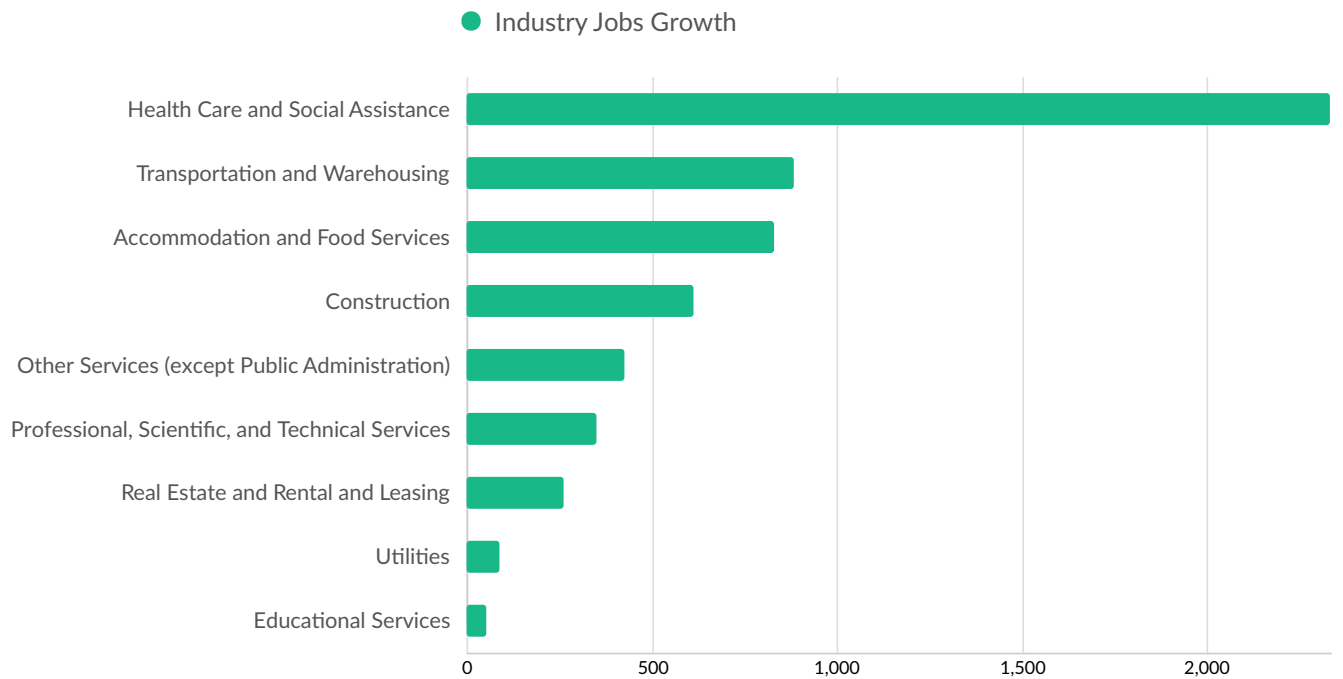
Solano County, CA has 26.44 property crimes per 1,000 people. The national rate is 18.22 per 1,000 people.

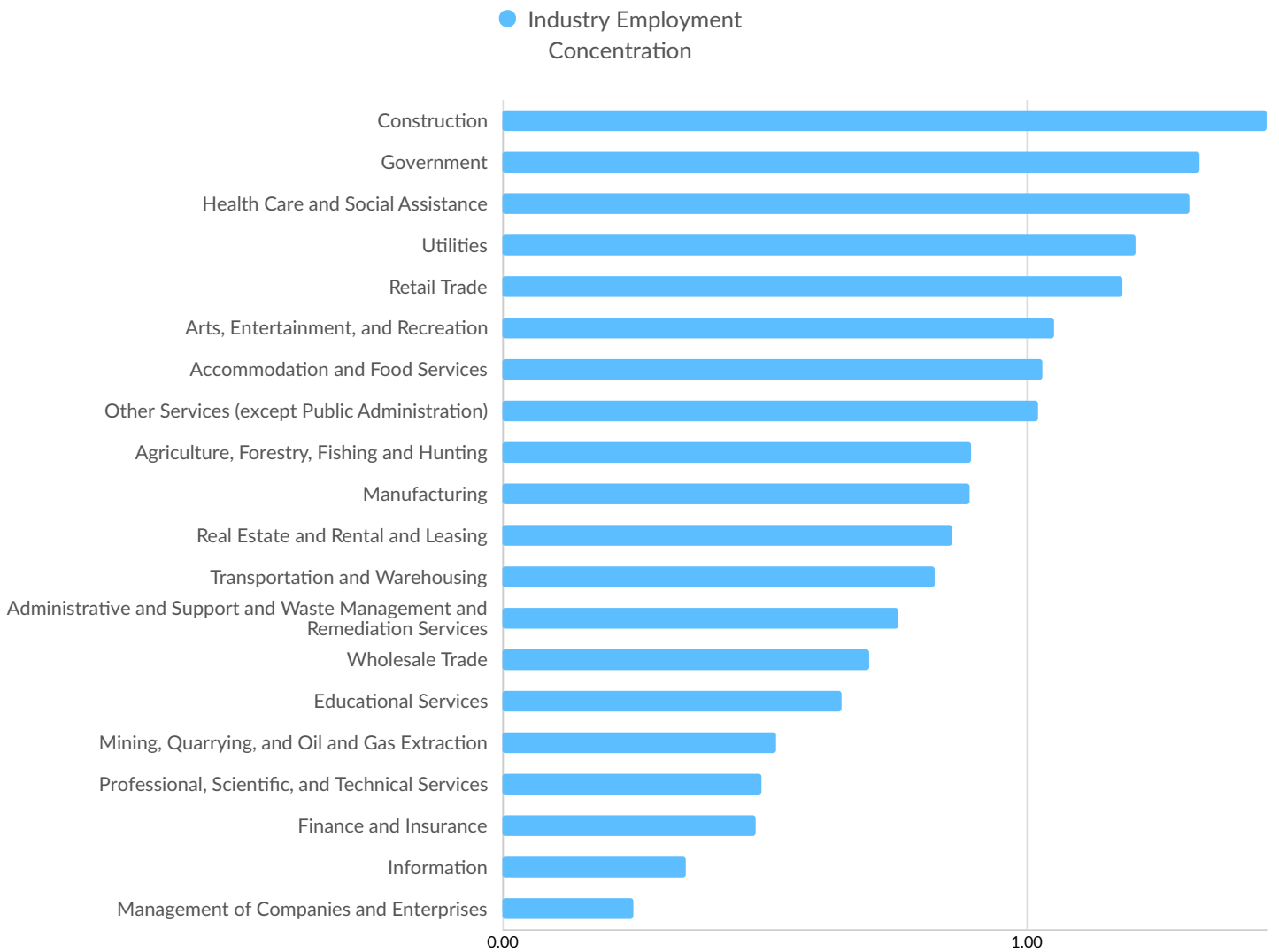

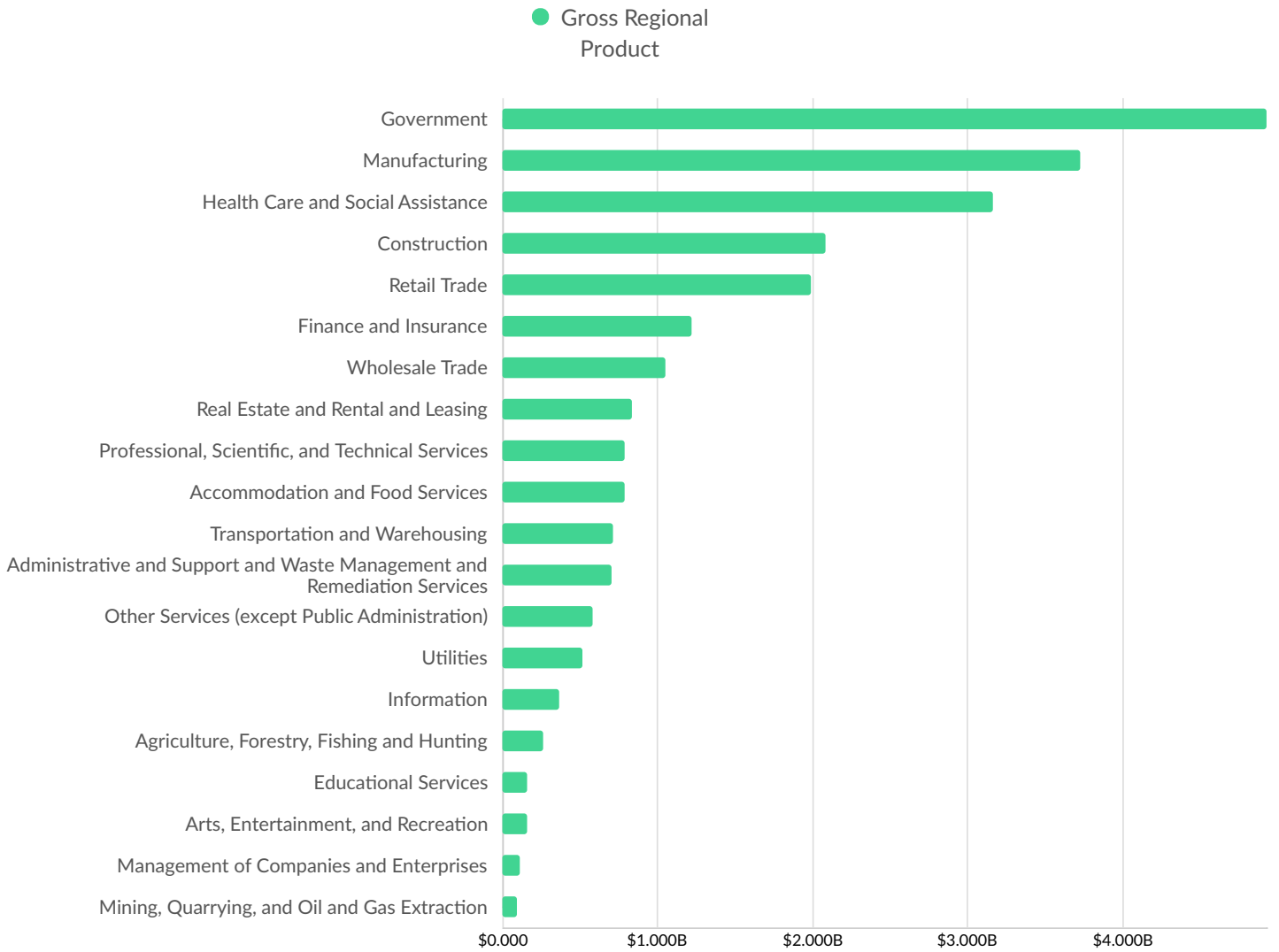
Top Growing Industries



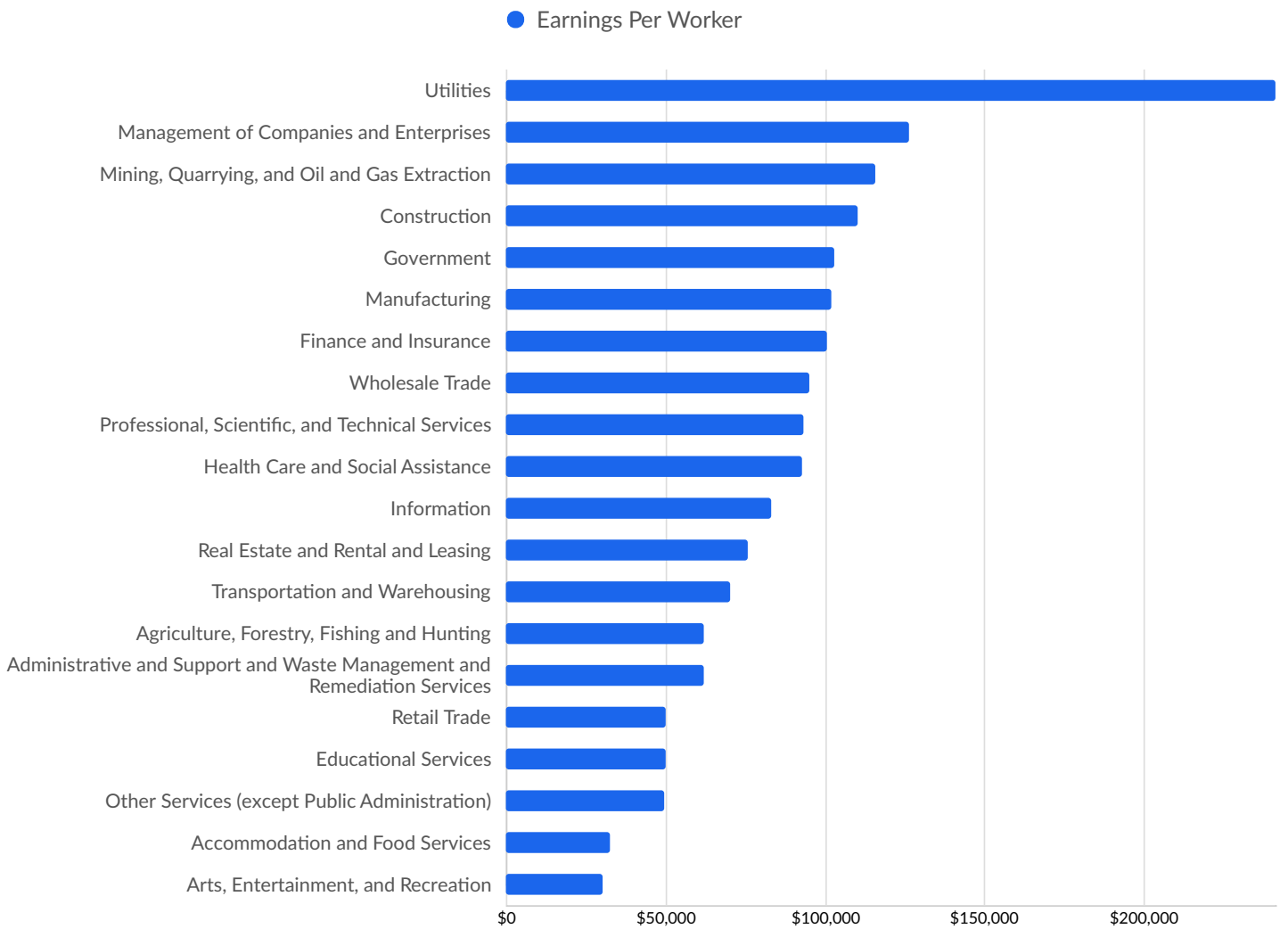
Top Industry Employment Concentration



Top Industry GRP

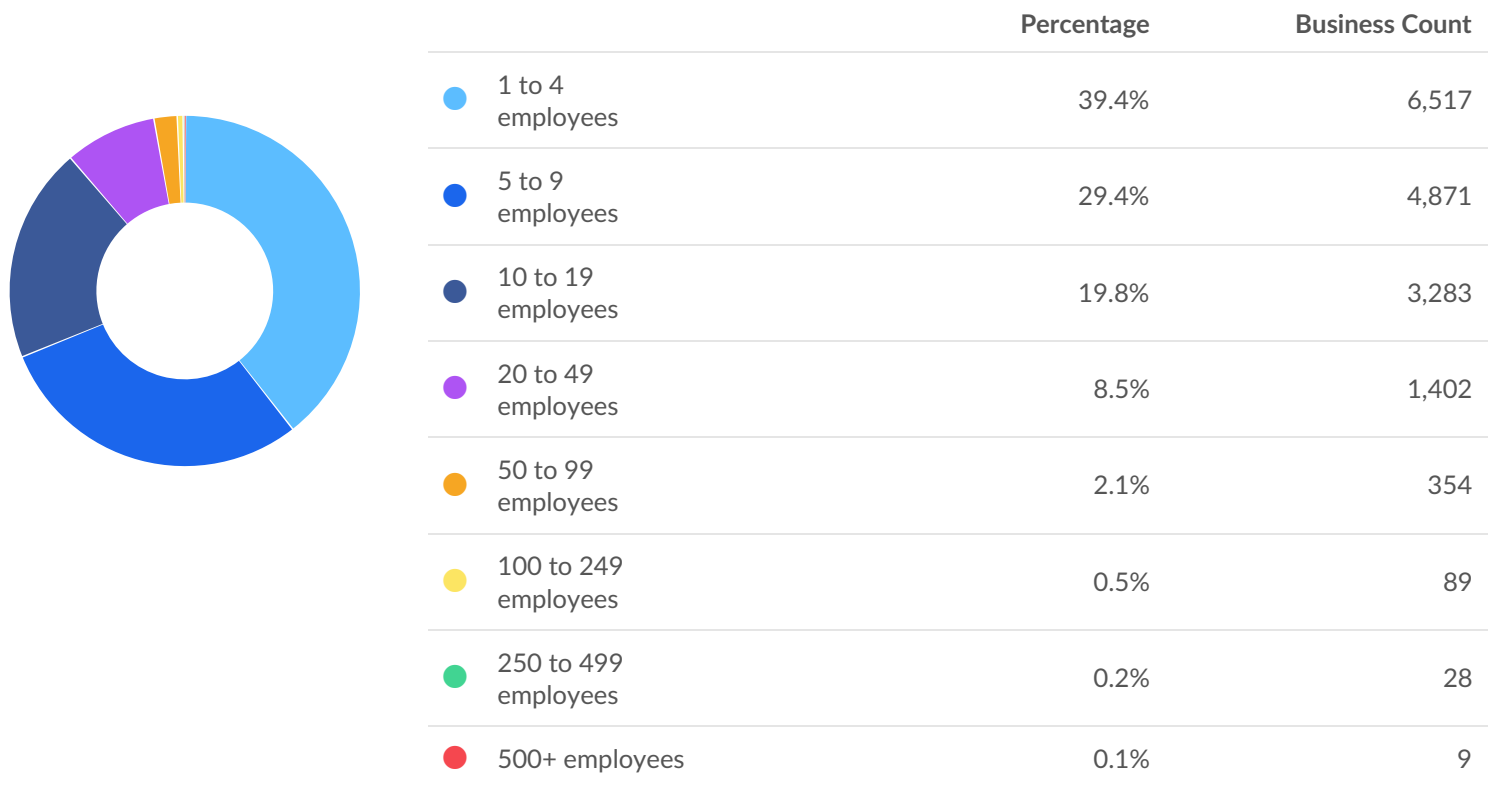

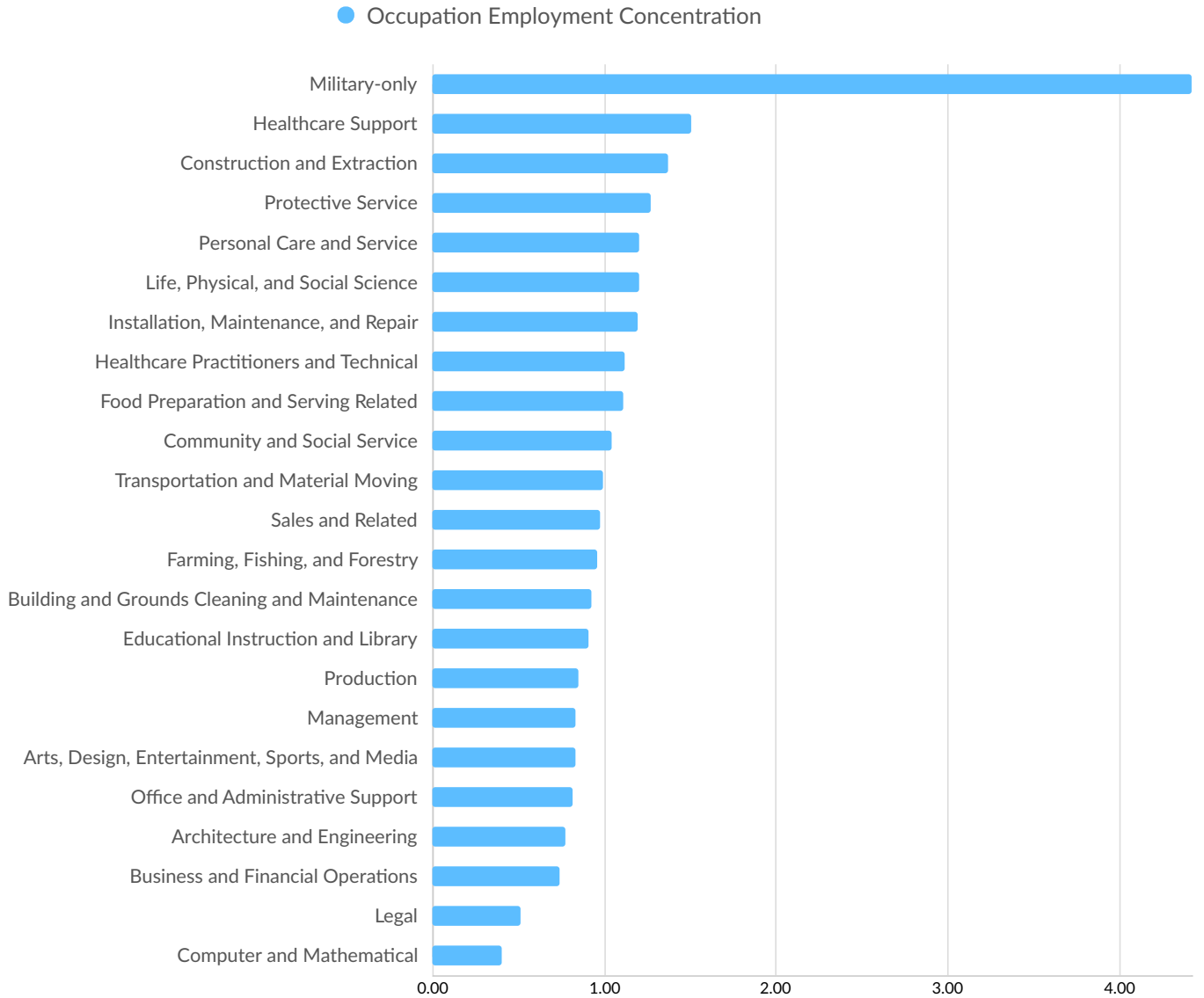

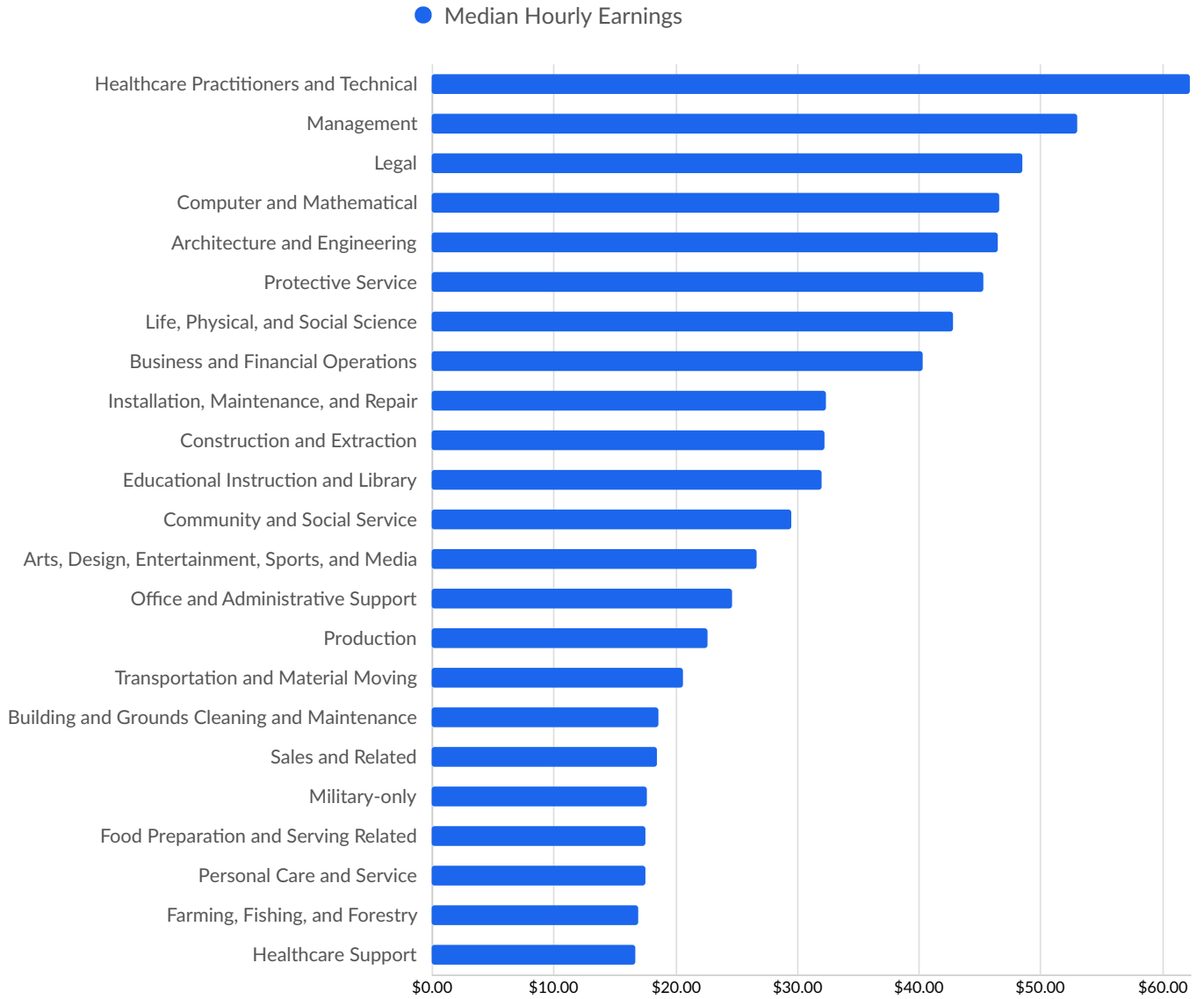
Top Growing Occupations
