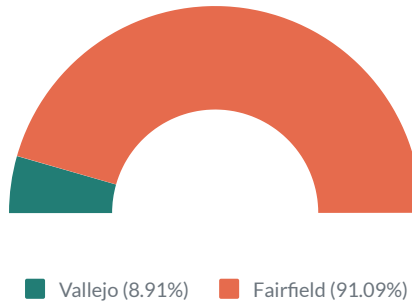
The America's Job Centers of California (AJCC) consists of partners who operate the job centers include Employment Development Department, the WDB, Division of Rehabilitation, and others.

The Workforce Board staff partnered with the North Bay Trades Introduction Program to host the fall 2021 trades pre-apprenticeship at the Fairfield AJCC.

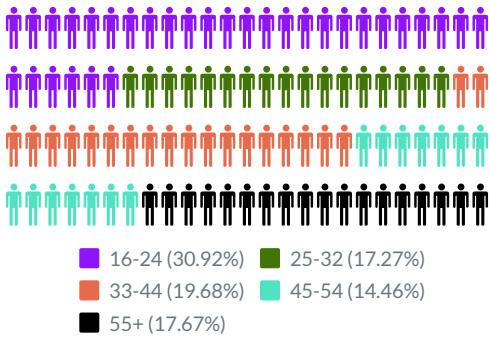

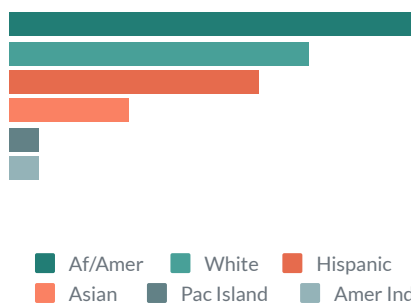
## Job Seeker Demographics

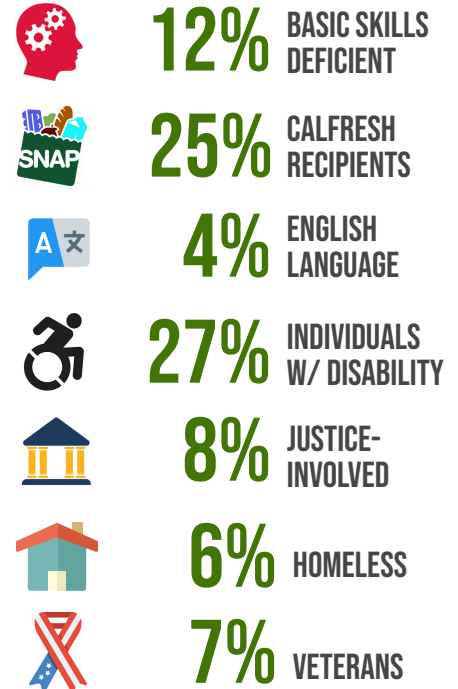

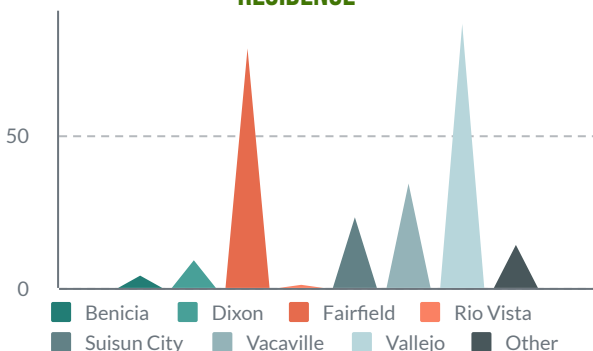
### RACE/ETHNICITY



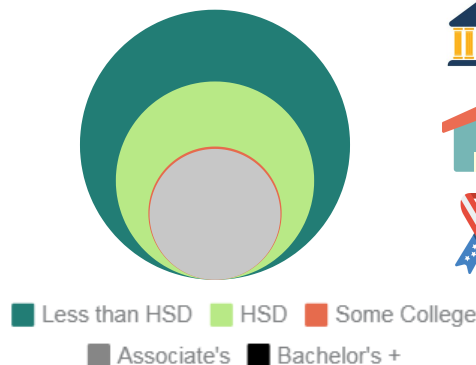
### PRIORITY POPULATIONS

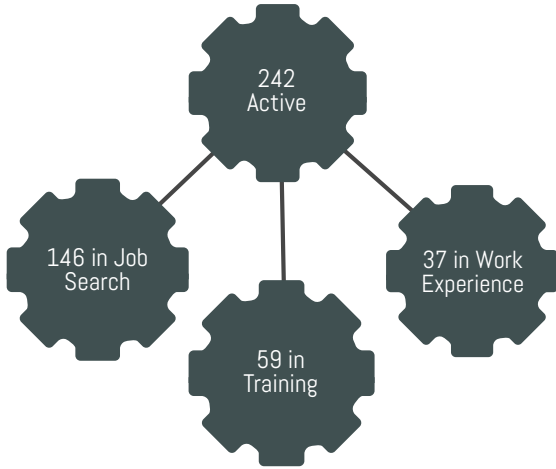




# Intensive Services

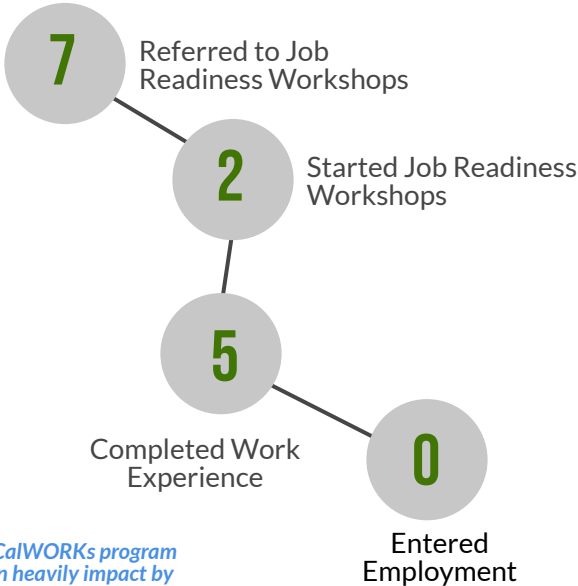
