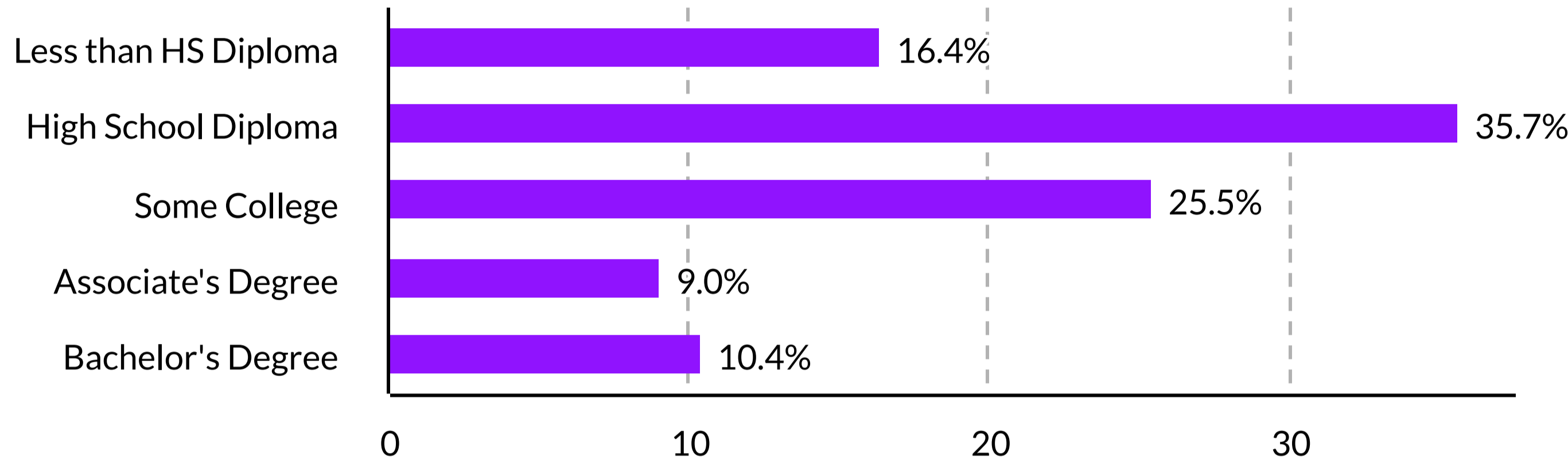

In 2020, the median compensation for Home Health and Personal Care Aides in Solano County, CA is \$29,079. Based on the national median wage of \$27,025 for this position, this means you will spend about 8% more to employ Home Health and Personal Care Aides here. However, their actual purchasing power will be 19% less than the national median when we adjust for regional cost of living (which is 32% higher than average). This may make it harder to attract talent to the region at this price.

Educational Attainment Breakdown



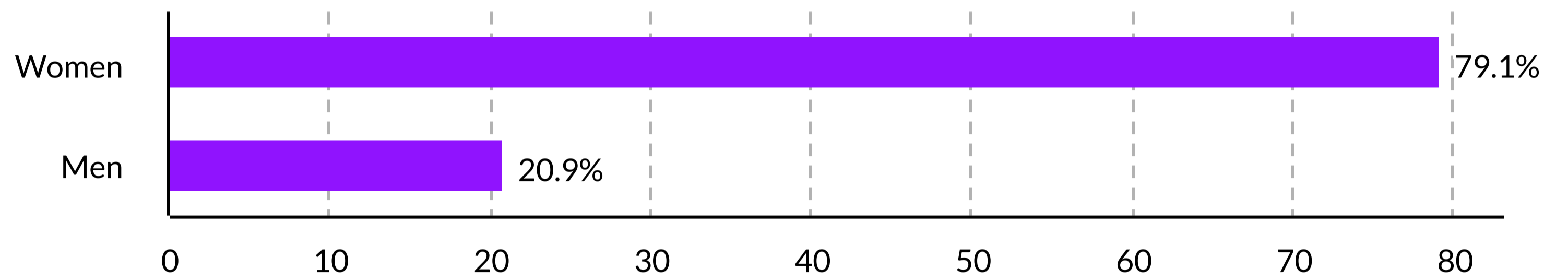

 10.4% hold an Associate's Degree (1.8% above the national average)

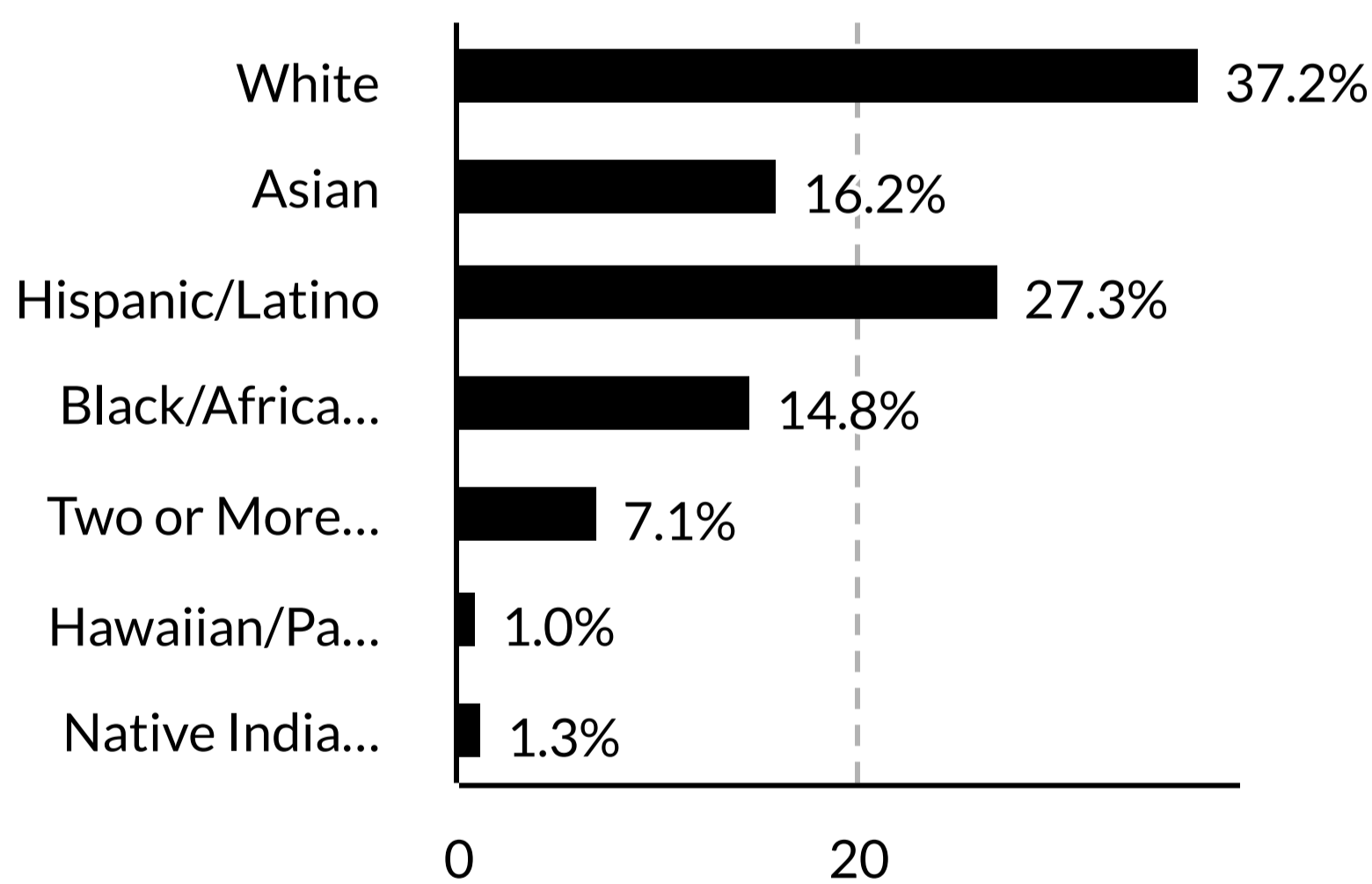
Solano County Gender Breakdown



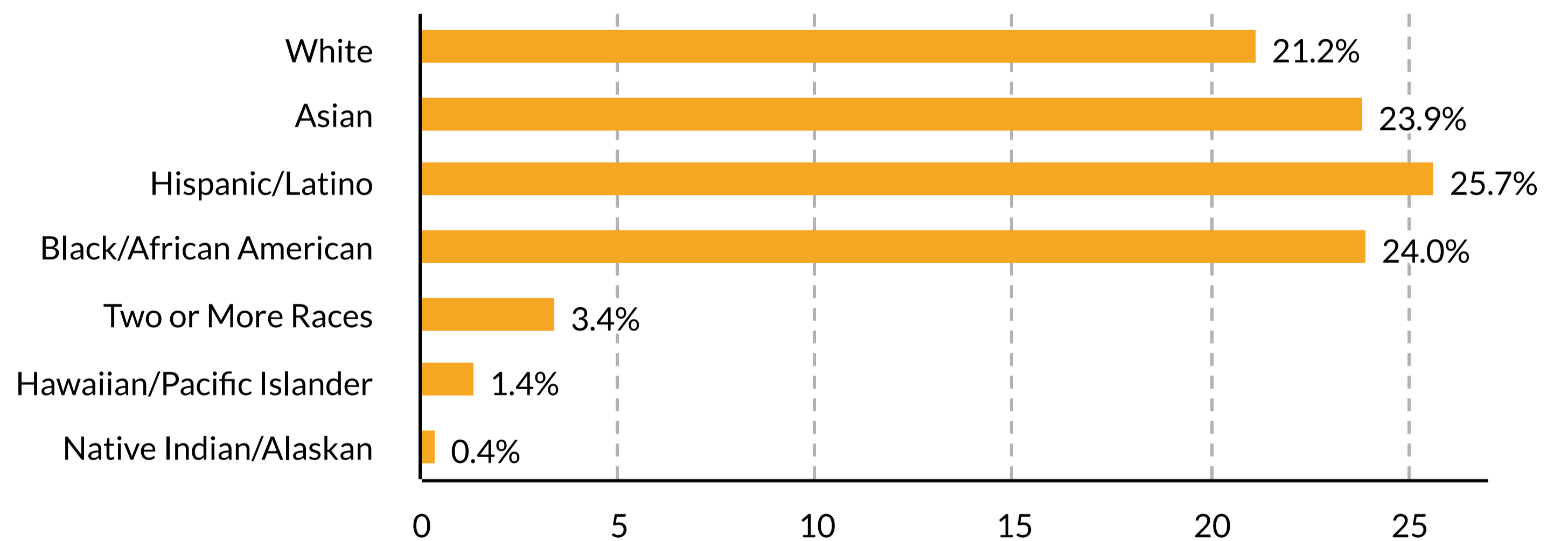
Occupation Gender Breakdown
