

**Prison to Employment Program: Earn and Learn Training Services
Written Questions and Answers**

Q1) We have a couple other contracts with the WDB and a number of our program participants are enrolled in those. Can those same individuals be enrolled in Earn and Learn Training Services, or can they only be counted as part of one grant contract?

A1) Co-enrollment across programs is allowable. Funds may be braided and leveraged across programs for the benefit of participants as long as funds are not duplicated for the same participant activity and the contract requirements of both funding streams are met. For example, an allowable use would be for one grant to cover the training component of a work and learn program, while another grant covers the participant wages associated with the program. Details of participant tracking would be negotiated in the contract development phase.
