## **HEAVY & TRACTOR TRAILER TRUCK DRIVERS (CLASS A)**

**Job Description:** Heavy and tractor-trailer truck drivers transport goods from one location to another.

**Educational Requirements:** Heavy and tractor-trailer truck drivers usually have a high school diploma and attend a professional truck driving school. They must have a commercial driver's license (CDL).

Demand: Expected to grow by 256 positions from 2021 - 2026 Average Hourly Earnings (2020): \$23.37

## Other Transportation Industry Job in Demand

## LIGHT TRUCK DRIVERS

**Job Description:** Delivery Truck Drivers and driver/sales workers pick up, transport, and drop off packages and small shipments within a local region or urban area.

**Educational Requirements:** Delivery Truck Drivers typically need a high school diploma or equivalent to enter these occupations. However, some opportunities exist for those without a high school diploma. Workers undergo I month or less of on-the-job training. They must have a driver's license from the state in which they work and have a clean driving record.

Demand: Expected to grow by 133 positions from 2021 - 2026 Average Hourly Earnings (2020): \$21.73
