

In 2020, the median compensation for Registered Nurses in Solano County, CA is \$72.36/hr. Based on the national median wage of \$36.19/hr for this position, this means you will spend about 100% more to employ Registered Nurses here. However, their actual purchasing power will be 51% greater than the national median when we adjust for regional cost of living (which is 32% higher than average). This may make it easier to attract talent to the region at this price.


Educational Attainment Breakdown




Concerning Educational Attainment

 10.4% hold an Associate's Degree (1.8% above the national average)


Solano County Gender Breakdown




Occupation Gender Breakdown
